

Effective November 5, 2021, the Minister of Health has authorized the following time-limited tariff to be paid during the COVID-19 pandemic response in Manitoba.

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- Notes:
- 1) Claims to be submitted to MHSAL within two (2) business days of service delivery.
 - 2) Half doses are to be only administered for third/booster doses for the populations identified in the Manitoba COVID-19 Vaccine Clinical Practice Guidelines for Immunizers and Health Care Providers
 - 3) The timing of the boosters should be based on the guidance in the Clinical Practice Guidelines but will generally be 6 months after the 2nd dose unless otherwise indicated.
 - 4) Physicians must report vaccine inventory to Public Health on a weekly basis and/or as directed by Public Health. The system for inventory reporting will be determined by Public Health and communicated to physicians.
 - 5) Determination of patient eligibility and obtaining patient consent are included within the fee.
 - 6) Physicians are required to schedule a third dose appointment with patients in accordance with recommended timing. Physicians are required to reasonably follow-up with patients to ensure the third dose is administered within recommended guidelines.
 - 7) Physicians shall provide equitable access for vaccinations for all eligible Manitobans regardless of whether the patient is in the physician's existing panel of patients.
 - 8) Manitoba Health has determined that this service, when provided during an after-hours period, is not urgent or emergent and therefore After Hours Premiums may not be claimed in addition.
 - 9) Physicians must review a patient's electronic COVID-19 immunization history through eChart or PHIMS to review any previous immunization history, interval between doses, if required, and product history to ensure third doses match the provincial recommendations.
 - 10) Physicians must ensure vaccine products are stored and handled as per the product monographs.
