- Notes:
- 1) Claims to be submitted to Manitoba Health within two (2) business days of service delivery.
 - 2) Physicians must report vaccine inventory to Public Health on a weekly basis and/or as directed by Public Health. The system for inventory reporting will be determined by Public Health and communicated to physicians.
 - 3) Determination of patient eligibility and obtaining patient consent are included within the fee.
 - 4) Physicians are required to schedule second and third dose appointments with patients based on the recommended intervals. Physicians are required to reasonably follow-up with patients to ensure all three doses within the series are administered within recommended guidelines.
 - 5) Physicians shall provide equitable access for vaccinations for all eligible Manitobans regardless of whether the patient is in the physician's existing panel of patients.
 - 6) Manitoba Health has determined that this service, when provided during an after-hours period, is not urgent or emergent and therefore After Hours Premiums may not be claimed in addition.
 - 7) Physicians must review a patient's electronic COVID-19 immunization history through eChart or PHIMS to review any previous immunization history, interval between doses, and product history to ensure all doses administered matches current provincial recommendations.
 - 8) Physicians must ensure vaccine products are stored and handled as per the product monographs.

Effective September 19, 2022, the Minister of Health has authorized the above time-limited tariff to be paid during the COVID-19 pandemic response in Manitoba (the duration of the tariff herein to be determined by Manitoba).
