The following petition was presented and read:

Mr. LAMOUREUX – Legislative Assembly of Manitoba to request the Legislative Assembly of Manitoba to consider the need to seek clarification on why the Government did not act on fixing the Crocus fund back in 2001. (N. Sankar, G. Sankar, C. Sankar and others)

Pursuant to Rule 26(1), Mrs. TAILLIEU, Ms. BRICK, Messrs. CULLEN and JENNISSEN and Hon. Mr. GERRARD made Members' Statements.

The House resumed the Interrupted Debate on the Proposed Motion of Hon. Ms. ALLAN:

THAT Bill (No. 7) – The Architects and Engineers Scope of Practice Dispute Settlement Act (Various Acts Amended)/Loi sur le règlement des différends portant sur le champ d'exercice des architectes et des ingénieurs (modification de diverses dispositions législatives), reported from the Standing Committee on Social and Economic Development, be concurred in and be now read for a Third Time and passed.

The Bill was accordingly concurred in, read a Third Time and passed.

And Hon. Mr. MACKINTOSH and Mr. GOERTZEN having spoken,

THAT Bill (No. 11) – The Winter Heating Cost Control Act/Loi sur la limitation des frais de chauffage en hiver, be now read a Second Time and be referred to a Committee of this House.

And Hon. Mr. GERRARD and Messrs. LAMOUREUX and CULLEN having spoken,

And Mr. MALOWAY speaking at 5:00 p.m. The debate was allowed to remain in his name and, by leave, in the name of Mr. DERKACH.
