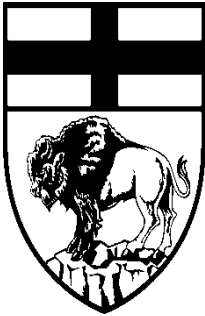

### PROPOSED RESOLUTION:

#### Mr. ALTEMEYER – Local Foods

14. WHEREAS connecting local food consumers with local food producers provides an important opportunity to strengthen our provincial economy and build positive relationships between rural and urban citizens; and

WHEREAS changing consumer focus on food safety and buying from local producers have recently propelled the establishment of multiple new agricultural operations in Manitoba; and

WHEREAS there are many innovative producers, marketers, grocers and consumers in Manitoba that are involved in creating a local food economy; and

WHEREAS local food cooperatives and other social enterprises provide on the ground supports and connectivity between farmers, producers and consumers; and

WHEREAS Manitoba is home to several thriving farmers' markets, notably the St. Norbert Farmers' Market and the Main Street Farmers' Market, in addition to the ubiquitous road-side fresh produce vendors; and

WHEREAS in April 2012, the Provincial Government announced an expansion of the Buy Manitoba program in partnership with local Safeway stores, increasing the visibility of the program; and

WHEREAS the Northern Healthy Foods Initiative help provide remote, Northern communities with sustainable and affordable fresh produce by providing funding to establish commercial agricultural and greenhouse programs; and

WHEREAS the Food Development Centre assists Manitoba's agri-food industry in the development and commercialization of food products, increasing the use of Manitoba ingredients for food and creating a positive economic impact for producers and Manitoba communities; and

WHEREAS the Provincial Government has, through the Education for Sustainable Development program, developed resources for educators and schools to help instill in our youth an awareness and commitment to sustainable development, including food security.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Manitoba Legislative Assembly commend the Provincial Government for partnering with communities, producers and individuals in helping to develop local food production and sustainable development.
