These Crown lands, due to their size, are approved for some night hunting to occur in a safe manner.

However, some areas within these lands cannot be used for night hunting if there is development, livestock operations, forestry activities, buildings, recreational activities, roads, trails, highways, or other types of human activity. It is your responsibility to ensure that you are aware of the activities that may be occurring within these lands that prevent you from hunting safely.

No night hunting is authorized in Provincial Parks before October 15, 2024.

No night hunting is authorized on any of the approved Crown Lands from November 11, 2024 to December 1, 2024 inclusive.

Ensure you are aware of the boundaries of the Crown lands you are hunting within.

Night hunting in a dangerous manner must not occur regardless if a permit is issued or not.
