

WILDLIFE SMART ABOUT BLACK BEARS

TIPS FOR KIDS

Here are some tips to be Wildlife Smart when you're in black bear country:

DO stay together as a group when you're outside. Don't run ahead or fall behind.

DON'T try to approach or feed black bears, or other wildlife.

DO pay attention to what's going on around you when you're outside. Leave earbuds and phones in your pocket.

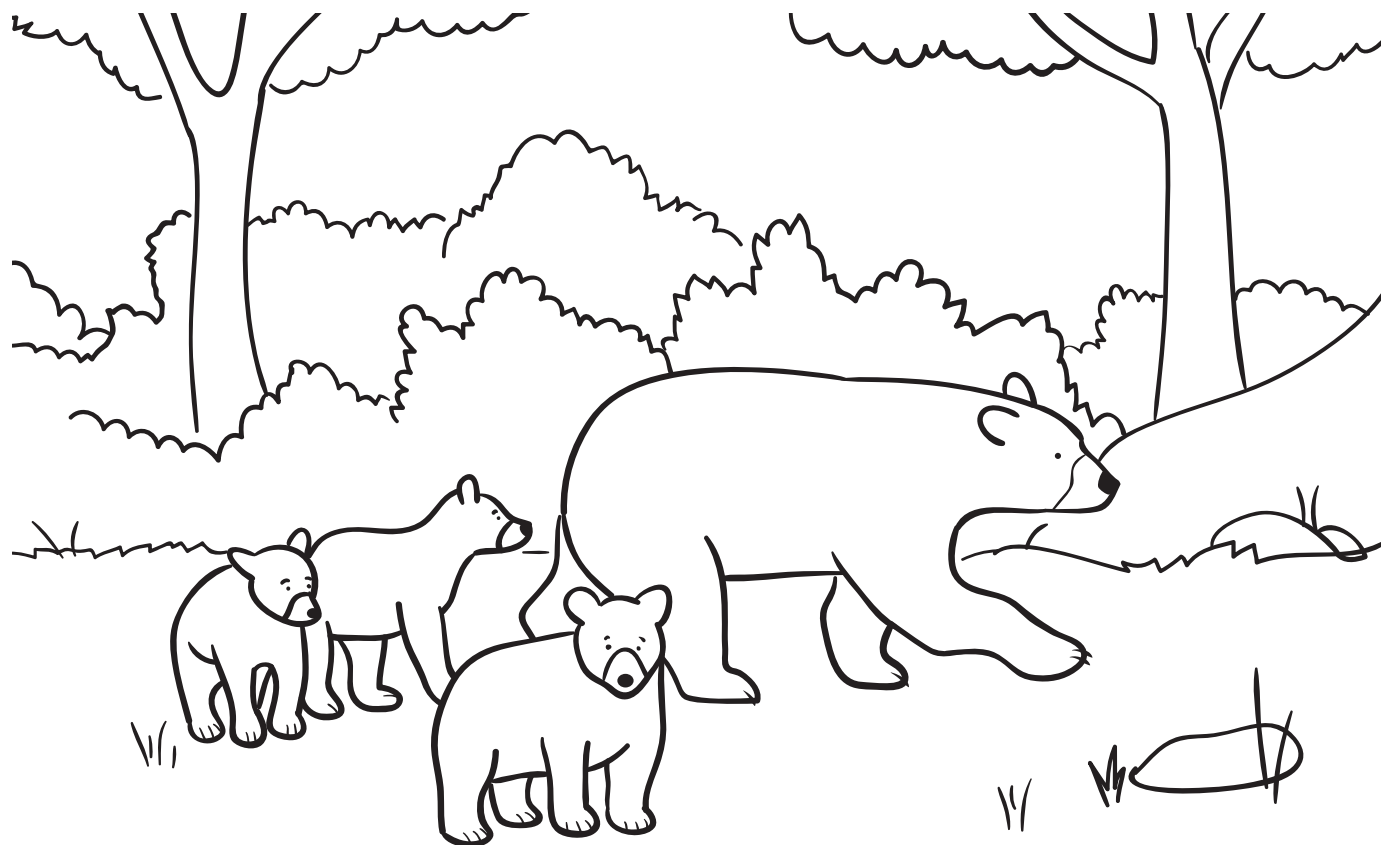
DO keep pets on leash and close to people.

DO help to keep your yard and campsite clean.

DO put garbage in a bear-resistant container or inside a sturdy building.

DO take down birdfeeders from April to November when black bears are active.

DO pick any fruit in your yard as it ripens, don't allow it to fall to the ground and rot.
