### **OVERVIEW:**

On January 8, 2001, the Department received an Application from Deviet Enterprises Ltd. for the development and operation of a waste lead acid battery transfer facility. Deviet had been located on Logan but has moved its operation to Eagle Drive. The Application was not complete and the Applicant was contacted and a more complete Application was received on February 2, 2001.

On February 19, 2001 the Department placed copies of the Application in the Public Registries located at 123 Main St. (Union Station), the Centennial Public Library and the Manitoba Eco-Network. As well, copies of the Application were provided to the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) members. The Department placed a public notification of the Application in the Winnipeg Free Press on February 24, 2001. The newspaper and TAC notification invited responses until March 19, 2001.
