In accordance with the Manitoba Environment Act (C.C.S.M. c. E125)

THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

MANITOBA POOL ELEVATORS; LICENCEE

subject to the specifications, limits, terms and conditions herein with respect to the Development being the operation of a grain elevator, including all related activities, at SW 1/4 25-9-2 WPM.

SPECIFICATIONS, LIMITS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. DEFINITIONS:

In this Licence,

- i) "opacity" means the degree to which visible emissions reduce the transmission of light and obscure the view of an object in the background;
- ii) "operation" includes all activities or processes, directly or indirectly related to the Development, and which are or may occur on or at SW 1/4 25-9-2 WPM;
- iii) "particulate matter" means any finely divided liquid or solid matter other than water droplets;
- iv) "particulate residue" means that part or portion of an atmospheric emission which is deposited onto a surface.

2. GENERAL:

The Licencee shall ensure that a high standard of equipment maintenance and good housekeeping and operational practices are carried out with respect to the Development, at all times.

3. RESTRICTIONS:

The emission of particulate matter from the operation, from any point of emission:

- i) shall not exceed 0.23 grams per dry standard cubic metre calculated at 25 degrees Celsius and 760 millimetres of mercury, corrected to 12 percent carbon dioxide for processes involving combustion;

- ii) shall not exhibit, at any point beyond the property line of the Development, a visible plume with an opacity of greater than 5 percent;
or
- iii) shall not result in any particulate residue occurring beyond the property line of the Development.

4. REVOCATION:

If in the opinion of the Director the Licencee has exceeded or is exceeding the limits set out herein, the Director may revoke, temporarily or permanently, this Licence.
