THIS STAGE 1 LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

Government Services Canada: "the Licencee"

for the construction of the Development being the replacement of and repairs to the movable dam elements on the St. Andrews Lock and Dam on the Red River at Lockport, subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:


Specifications, Limits, Terms and Conditions

- 1) The Licencee shall construct the Development in accordance with methods outlined in the Environment Act Proposal dated September 8, 1993, and the accompanying report "Initial Environmental Assessment Proposed Fixed and Movable Dam Repairs St. Andrews Lock and Dam, Lockport, Manitoba"
- 2) The Licencee shall, during the full term of the construction of the Development, clean up and deposit all debris from the construction site at a Waste Disposal Ground operating under the authority of a permit issued pursuant to *Manitoba Regulation 150/91R* respecting *Waste Disposal Grounds*.
- 3) The Licencee shall ensure that all debris resulting from construction is removed from the banks and ice surface of the Red River prior to the breakup of the ice surface in the spring of 1994 and each succeeding year of construction.
- 4) The Licencee shall ensure that all waste oil products generated by the machinery used in the construction of the Development are collected and disposed of in accordance with applicable Manitoba Environment and legislation requirements.
- 5) The Licencee shall, during construction, ensure that fuel storage areas established for the construction of the Development shall comply with the requirements of *Manitoba Regulation 97/88R* respecting *Storage and Handling of Gasoline and Associated Products*.
