In accordance with the Manitoba Environment Act (C.C.S.M. c. E125)

THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

**THE PROVINCE OF MANITOBA REPRESENTED BY THE
MINISTER OF HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION: "the Licencee"**

for the construction of the Development being the upgrading of a section of Provincial Road #241 located in parts of River Lots 23-45 in the Parish of St. Francois Xavier, Rural Municipality of Cartier, beginning at PTH #1 and extending in a south/south-easterly direction to Provincial Road #424 subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:

SPECIFICATIONS, LIMITS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The Licencee shall construct the Development in accordance with the *Environment Act Proposal, Proposed Relocation of Provincial Road 241 (from PTH #1 to PR #424)*, dated March 24, 1994.
2. The Licencee shall re-grade the ditches disturbed during construction of the development and seed the disturbed areas with a mix of native or introduced grasses or legumes.
3. The Licencee shall, during construction, comply with all requirements of *Manitoba Regulation 97/88R* respecting *Storage and Handling of Gasoline and Associated Products*.
4. The Licencee shall, during and upon completion of construction, cleanup and remove all debris from the construction site and dispose of the debris at a Waste Disposal Ground operating under the authority of a permit issued pursuant to *Manitoba Regulation 150/91R* respecting *Waste Disposal Grounds*.

REVOCATION

If in the opinion of the Director the Licencee has exceeded or is exceeding the limits, or has not or is not complying with the specifications, terms and conditions set out herein, the Director may revoke temporarily or permanently, this Licence.
