

AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION
 UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

RE: THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION and RED RIVER BRICK & TILE DIVISION OF I.XL INDUSTRIES LTD., Applicant,

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, Red River Brick & Tile Division of I.XL Industries Ltd. filed an application with the Department of Mines, Resources and Environmental Management in connection with the operation of a brick manufacturing plant located near P.T.H. No. 44 East in the unincorporated village of Lockport in the Rural Municipality of St. Clements, Manitoba;

AND WHEREAS in the absence of limits being prescribed by a Regulation under the said Act, the application was referred to The Clean Environment Commission for the prescribing of limits;

AND WHEREAS representations were received by the Commission from persons who were or who are likely to be affected by an Order of the Commission prescribing limits in connection with the said operation;

AND WHEREAS the said Commission held a public hearing in East Selkirk on the 4th day of October, 1978;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

1. The Applicant shall ensure that solid particulate emissions from any stack or vent of the said operation do not exceed a concentration of 0.57 grams per standard cubic metre of dry, undiluted exhaust gases calculated at 25 degrees Celsius and 760 millimetres of mercury.
2. The Applicant shall ensure that particulate matter and dust emissions from any part of the said operation do not exhibit an opacity in excess of 5 percent at any point of impingement off the premises of the said operation.
3. The Applicant shall ensure that a high standard of housekeeping and maintenance is carried out in a manner consistent with meeting the requirements of this Order.

4. The Applicant shall take appropriate action to ensure that, on and after the 1st day of April, 1977, the deposition of clay on P.T.H. No. 44 by vehicles leaving the premises of the said operation is discontinued.
