Re: Notice of Alteration – Environment Act Licence 3014 – Receipt and Treatment of Hydrovac Slurry

Thank you for your April 20, 2016 Notice of Alteration (NOA) to Environment Act Licence No. 3014 R for the MidCanada Environmental Services Ltd soil treatment facility. The alteration consists of the installation of bins for the receipt and treatment of slurry from hydraulic excavation and boring (hydrovac) projects, and the inclusion of a definition to allow this material to be accepted at the facility.

Upon review of your alteration request, I have concluded that the environmental effects of the proposed alteration will be insignificant, and, therefore, in accordance with Section 14(2) of *The Environment Act* you are hereby authorized to carry out the proposed alteration as described in the April 20, 2016 Notice of Alteration with the following conditions:

1. Notification to the Environment Officer, Krista.olafsson@gov.mb.ca in writing 5 days prior to commencing the modifications to the facility and upon completion of the alterations; and
2. All run off from the ramped area leading up to the bins must be contained within the bermed area of the facility.
