**Re: Carman wastewater treatment lagoon - wastewater effluent limit for phosphorus in effect January 1, 2016**

As you have been previously notified, your wastewater treatment lagoon at Carman is required to meet the 1 mg/L phosphorus limit as of January 1, 2016 in accordance with the Water Quality Standards, Objectives and Guidelines Regulation under *The Water Protection Act*.

Your wastewater treatment lagoon for the Town of Carman operates under Environment Act Licence 2399. In addition to meeting the 1 mg/L phosphorus limit and in accordance with Clause 5 of Licence 2399, you are hereby required to sample, analyze and report on the total phosphorus content of your wastewater effluent prior to discharging to surface water.

Additionally, you were requested in a March 6, 2015 letter from Environment Officer Tyler Kneeshaw to submit a Notice of Alteration for alterations made without prior approval as required by *The Environment Act* prior to conducting any additional work. To date, no Notice of Alteration has been received. You are hereby required, prior to January 31, 2016, to submit the Notice of Alteration describing the work undertaken and any planned additional work. The Notice of Alteration Fee of \$500 must be submitted with the notice.
