Re: Lake Winnipeg East System Improvement Project – Environment Act Licence No. 3120

This is in regard to your letter dated January 20, 2017 requesting approval to refuel equipment at a location within 100 metres from a waterbody.

The Environmental Approvals Branch is processing this request as a minor alteration to Environment Act Licence No. 3120, pursuant to clause 14(2)(b) of *The Environment Act*. In accordance with Section 14(2) of *The Environment Act*, I herby grant approval to Manitoba Hydro to implement the proposed alteration, as described in the request, and subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The containment berm must be constructed of material(s) suitable for the containment and recovery of spills;
- 2. The fuel tank must be Transport Canada certified;
- 3. There must be adequate lighting during fueling; and
- 4. No fueling shall occur at within 100 metres of a waterbody in association with this Development after February 28, 2017.
