George Johnstone served as surgeon at Fort Rupert in outfit years 1851 and 1852 (an outfit runs from 1 June to 31 May). (B.239/g/31 fo.37, B.239/k/3 p. 39). His wages are noted as £100 per annum. (B.239/g/32 fo.64, B.226/1/1 fo.22). He is listed as serving in the capacity of surgeon in the Nanaimio District from 1853 until May 1855 when a notation in the records indicates that he 'returned home'. (B.226/g/1 fo.2, B.226/g/2 fo.2, B.239/k/3 fos. 60,84). It appears, however, that he maintained an account with the Company until 1857. (B.226/g/3 fos. 25d-26, B.226/g/4 fo.20d). No reference to him has been traced after 1857.
