Legislative Library News

This month's Selected New Titles focuses on homegrown talent and subjects. All titles on the October list were produced or published in Manitoba.

The Manitoba Legislative Library's collection of Manitoba publications is older than the Library itself, and includes newspapers, histories, government documents and personal libraries. Since 1919, all Manitoba publishers are required to send one copy of each publication to the Library free of charge. The practice continues to this day, and helps the Library to maintain as complete a collection as possible of Manitoba publications.

As current Manitoba publications are received, they are made available to library users through the work of library staff. All materials may be used in the Library by researchers, government employees and the general public, but do not circulate outside the Library. This ensures that the Library is able to collect and preserve these materials, and make them accessible for future researchers.
